The Health and Welfare Sector Education and Training Authority (HWSETA) invites all registered and accredited service providers to participate in training of unemployed Community Education and Training (CET) College's learners.

Details of the Training

The HWSETA invites registered and accredited Skills Development Providers to train **twenty (20)** unemployed CET learners on the occupational certificate/qualification listed above.

The successful Skills Development Provider will be required to:

- Liaise with CETs regarding the training of the identified unemployed CET learners (4 learners per province) in five provinces (Western Cape, Kwa-Zulu Natal, Mpumalanga, Northwest, Free State).
- Co-ordinate the registration of the learners with QCTO.
- Coordinate and deliver face to face training in its entirety including training of Knowledge, Practical and workplace components.
- Place learners at a workplace.
- Conduct formative and summative assessments (mock EISA) aligning to the exemplars provided by HWSETA.
- Manage the distribution of learners' stipends (R3 500.00 per learner per month for six (6) months).
- Coordinate all communication with the CETs regarding the training of the identified learners.
- Administer all mandatory and compliance documents required by the HWSETA
- Provide the HWSETA will all required reporting documents
- Coordinate issuing of learners' Statement of results for entry into EISA.
- Distribute Statement of achievements and the certificates to competent learners.
- Liaise with HWSETA provinces for performance reporting as per the HWSETA requirements.

Qualifying criteria:

The skills development Provider must comply with the following requirements:

- Be accredited as a Skills Development Provider by QCTO for the identified occupational qualification (Evidence required).
- Co-ordinate and liaise with the CETs regarding the registration of learners with QCTO.
- Coordinate the placement of learners to write the External integrated Summative assessment (EISA).
- Be accredited as an Assessment Centre by QCTO for the relevant occupational qualification (evidence required).
- Have capacity to train in the five different provinces as learners will be from different provinces.
- Provide a **Mock project plan** on how the training will be rolled out in the five identified provinces.
- Have two (02) years' experience in training against the identified qualification. Two reference letters are required.
- Be able to complete training no later than **30 January 2027**.

Note that Only one Skills Development provider will be appointed for the implementation of this project.

- **Compulsory compliance documents** to be submitted are as follows:
 1. Proof of company registration (CIPC document).
 2. Proof of registration on CSD.
 3. Valid Tax pin and Proof of Tax compliance on CSD.
 4. Valid Accreditation letter for the qualification applied for (SDP and Assessment Centre).
 5. Two reference letters with letter heads, signed and dated.
