The HWSETA is inviting registered and accredited service providers to deliver training to **fifty-nine (59) College Lecturers** for Facilitating Learning Using a Variety of Given Methodologies skills programme, and to **fourteen (14) education managers** for Design and Develop Outcomes-Based Assessments skills programme, as outlined above.

The appointed service provider will be responsible for:

- Engaging with Community Education and Training (CET) institutions, Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) colleges, Nursing colleges, Regional training centres, and Emergency services regarding the training of identified lecturers and education managers.
- Managing and coordinating all communication with the institutions concerning the selected lecturers and education managers
- Planning, coordinating, and delivering the full training programme.
- Delivering training through face-to-face interaction.
- Handling all required administrative and compliance documentation in line with HWSETA requirements.
- Submitting all necessary reports to the HWSETA.
- Facilitating the certification of learners through the appropriate quality assurance body.

Qualifying criteria:

- The Skills Development Provider must be **accredited** by the relevant quality assurance body to offer both skills programmes.
- A minimum of **two (2) years’ experience** in delivering training aligned to these programmes is required, supported by references and verifiable proof of previously trained learners (minimum 2 references).

- The Skills Development Provider must have at least **(2) two years** of overall experience in the training sector.
- The Skills Development Provider must have a national footprint, as participants will be drawn from different Provinces.
- A mock project plan outlining how the training will be implemented across various provinces must be submitted.

Compulsory compliance documents are as follows:

1. Proof of CIPC registration.
2. Proof of registration on CSD
3. Valid Tax pin and Proof of Tax compliance on CSD
4. Valid Accreditation letter of the programme applied for.
5. Two reference letters of previous training implementation.
