The Health and Welfare Sector Education and Training Authority (HWSETA) invites Skills Development Providers (SDPs), with valid accreditation, to send proposals for inclusion in the incubation programme to implement RPL assessments and top-up training for the following qualification:

Note: The Skills Development Providers (SDPs) must have the financial ability to fund travel and accommodation of the Official/s attending the incubation programme and have in-depth understanding of RPL.

1. FUNCTIONALITY REQUIREMENTS

1.1 All proposals will be evaluated based on the criteria indicated hereunder.

The Skills Development Provider must:

- 1.1.1 be accredited for the qualification (SAQA ID 60902: FETC: Child and Youth Care Work, NQF Level 04, 165 Credits) and the accreditation must be valid at the point of submitting the proposal to HWSETA.
- 1.1.2 have maximum two (2) employed/contracted Assessor/s and two (2) Moderator/s, who attended the HWSETA RPL capacity-building workshops and have completed all the four (04) RPL unit standards. (SAQA ID 12544, SAQA ID 117874, SAQA ID 14297 and SAQA ID 116587)
- 1.1.3 have maximum two (2) Assessor/s and two (2) Moderator/s who have a minimum of three (03) years' experience in RPL assessment and hold registration as Assessor/s and Moderator/s for the Child and Youth Care Work qualification: SAQA ID 60902 at NQF Level 04, with 165 Credits.
- 1.1.4 for future implementation of RPL assessments: be accredited or in the process of getting QCTO accreditation for the Occupational qualification: SAQA ID: 125059: Higher

Occupational Certificate: Auxiliary Child and Youth Care Worker, NQF Level 05, 194 Credits.

Organisations will be evaluated on strict technical functionality criteria to determine suitability for the task at hand and only organisations that achieve the requisite score for functionality will proceed to the selection for incubation.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Note: that bids will be evaluated on functionality separately first. Proposals scoring less than 80% on functionality will not be considered further in the evaluation and will be disqualified. Only organisations that achieve the requisite score for functionality will proceed to the selection for incubation.

(SAQA ID 12544, SAQA ID 117874, SAQA ID 14297 and SAQA ID 116587) (05 points for ETDP statement of results per assessor and 05 points for ETDP statement of results per moderator)</p>	20 points
<p>Criteria 3: 3.1 Have maximum two (2) Assessor/s and two (2) Moderator/s who have a minimum of three (03) years' experience in RPL assessment and hold registration as Assessor/s and Moderator/s for the Child and Youth Care Work qualification: SAQA ID 60209 at NQF Level 04, with 165 Credits. (05 points for assessor registration letter, 05 points for moderator registration letter, 05 points for assessor's CV with 3 years' experience and 05 points for moderator's CV with 3 years' experience)</p>	40 points
