Subject: THE USAGE OF HWSETA STANDARDIZED LEARNING MATERIAL FOR OCCUPATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

Dear Stakeholder

The Health and Welfare Sector Education and Training Authority (HWSETA) is responsible for creating a skilled workforce for both the health and social development sectors in South Africa. Standardized learning material helps to support this initiative to provide quality training. The HWSETA has standardized learning material for 3 occupational qualifications that have been approved and endorsed by relevant professional bodies and or experts in the field. Accredited SDPs are requested to use this material to prepare learners for the mock examination as well as the External Integrated Summative Assessment (EISA).

Currently, the workshops on the implementation of the learning material aligned with the 3 occupational qualifications that are being rolled out, are compulsory. It is expected that the SDP Managers/Director/owners (seeking accreditation, already accredited and applying for extension of scope) together with at least two facilitators from each SDP must attend the workshops on the roll-out of the material, for them to access the standardized learning material.

Please Note: If any SDP wishes to utilize their own learning material, they should compare the content of their learning material with the HWSETA standardized learning material to ensure that they address any gaps that may be identified so that the learners are not disadvantaged during the writing of the EISA, because the assessment instruments are always based on the HWSETA standardized learning material.
