The Health and Welfare Sector Education and Training Authority ("HWSETA") invites registered Community Education Colleges (CETs) (Eastern Cape, Gauteng, Kwa-Zulu Natal, Limpopo, Northern Cape) to participate in the implementation of Adult Education and Training of Unemployed CET learners for 2025-2026.

**Details of the Adult Education and Training Programme**

The HWSETA invites all Community Education Colleges, to participate in the implementation of the Adult Education and Training. This project will focus on a formal training intervention for CET unemployed learners to access and complete formal Adult Education and Training (AET) programmes. Training has been broken down into the following categories:

**Qualifying criteria:**

- For Home Based Care Assistant NQF 2, CET unemployed learners with grade 9 or NQF 1 equivalent as a minimum requirement
- For Home Based Personal Worker NQF 3, CET unemployed learners with grade 10 or NQF 2 equivalent as a minimum requirement
- All CETs must ensure that applications are done in line with the requirements of the grant as indicated under details of the funding, and all the required attachments accompany the application.
- CETs who focus on the training and development of persons with disabilities will be given preference.
- Previous participation performance in HWSETA projects will be used as a criterion.
- The HWSETA may conduct a site verification visit at its Discretion prior to Approval

- All applications must be submitted on the HWSETA application portal by the due date in line with the requirements of the grant as indicated under details of the funding, and all the required attachments accompany the application.
- Learners applied for must not be above the age of 60 years.
- The Registration status of the CET learners is valid at the time of application and throughout the implementation of the project.

**Please Note: CETs who meet the qualifying criteria are welcomed to apply as service providers**

**Applications as a service provider are available on the HWSETA website.  
The HWSETA reserves the right to withdraw the approval if:**

- The information provided in the application form is not true and correct; or
- The CETs do not adhere to any of the requirements laid down by the HWSETA.
- Registration status of the CET learners ceases to exist before or during the commencement of the project.
